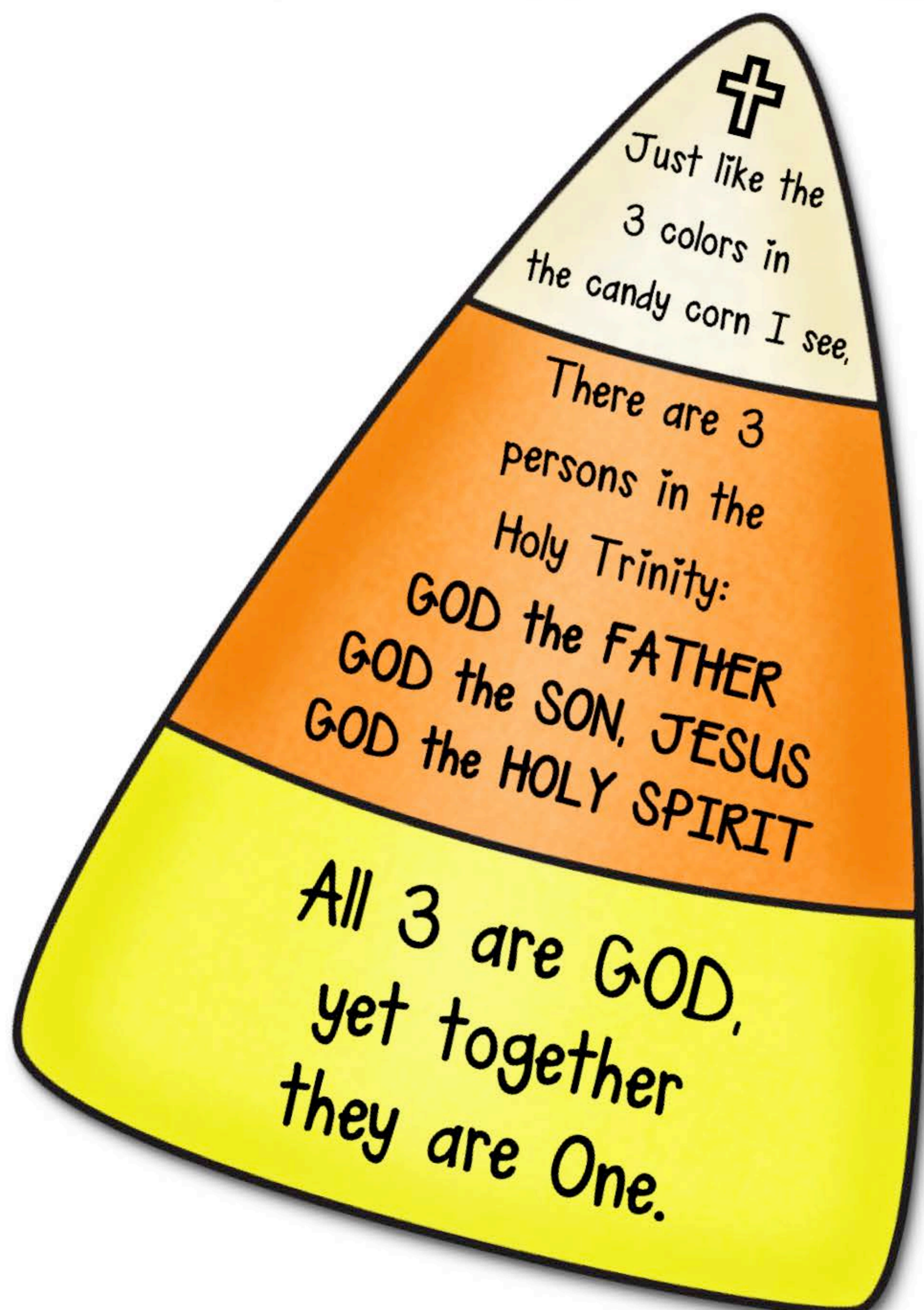

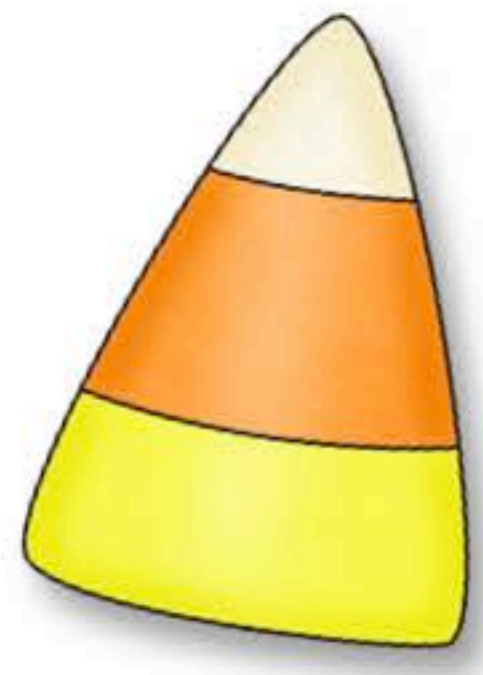


Just like the

Trinity

The word 'trinity' is not found in the Bible, however, it is definitely a Biblical principal that seeks to describe the nature of God.

- God is three persons.
- Each person is divine.
- There is only one God

Here are a few scripture verses for background:

2 Cor. 13:14, "The grace of the Lord Jesus Christ, and the love of God, and the fellowship of the Holy Spirit, be with you all."

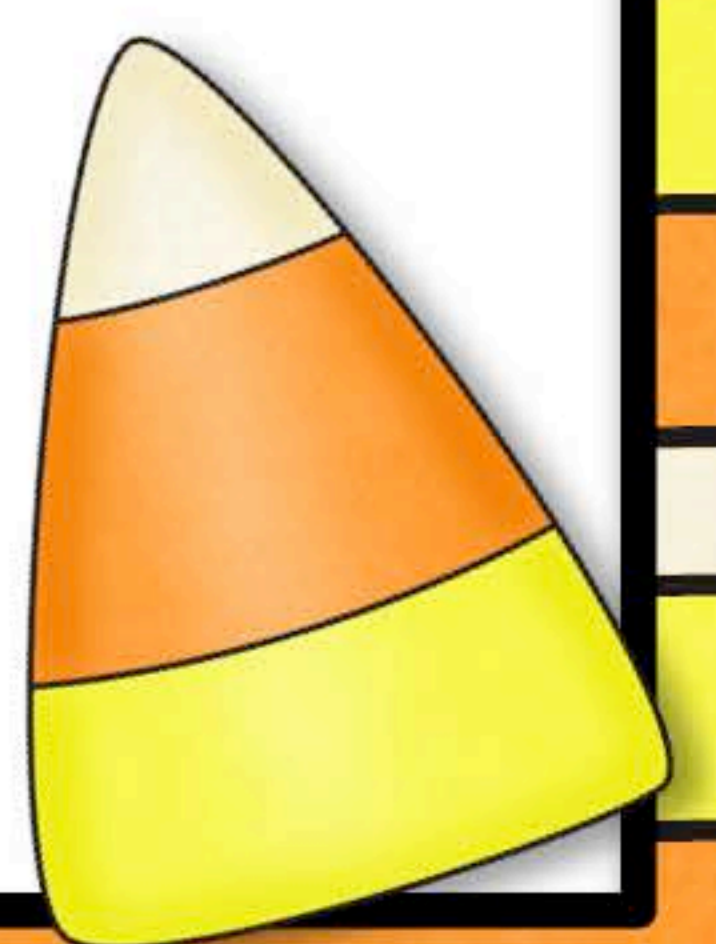
Matt. 28:19, "Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit."

1 Pet. 1:2, "according to the foreknowledge of God the Father, by the sanctifying work of the Spirit, that you may obey Jesus Christ and be sprinkled with His blood: May grace and peace be yours in fullest measure."

Jude 20-21, "But you, beloved, building yourselves up on your most holy faith; praying in the Holy Spirit; 2 I keep yourselves in the love of God, waiting anxiously for the mercy of our Lord Jesus Christ to eternal life."

It is a difficult theological truth to understand at any age. Using examples from real life often helps us to understand spiritual truths. St. Patrick used the shamrock to illustrate how 3 parts (leaves) made 1 whole (shamrock).

Candy Corn can also illustrate this, 3 colors, 1 candy.



Directions

I have included 3 options for you to choose from, depending on how much time and materials you want to use.

Option #1

1. Prep: Copy on white, copy background on black.
2. Students: Color, Cut, Glue on background
3. Tape string on back for a hanger.

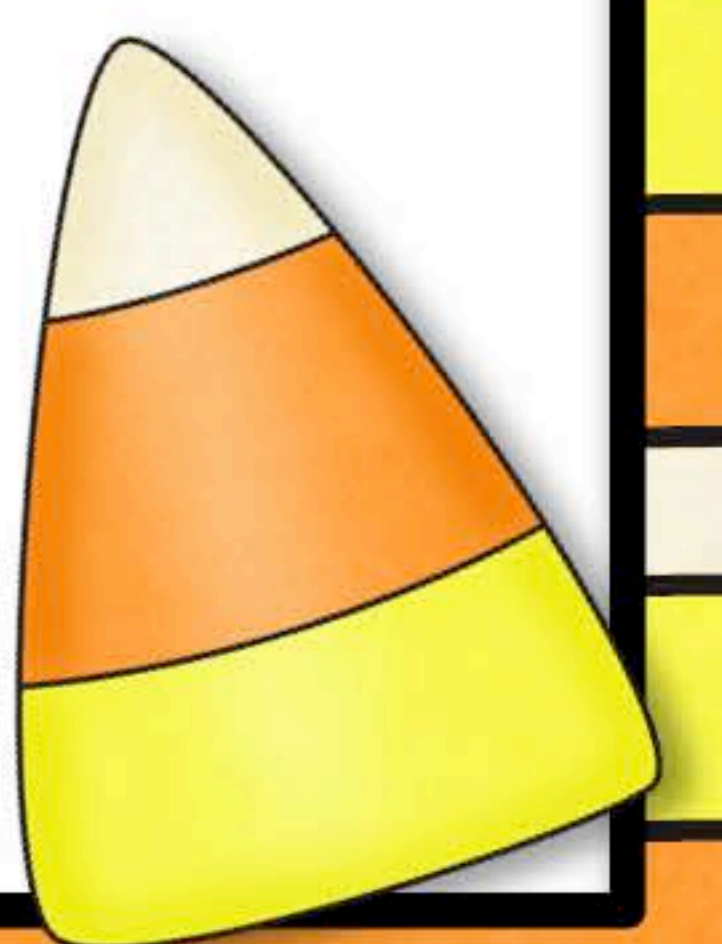
Option #2

1. Prep: Copy on white.
2. Students: color, cut, background is optional.
3. Tape string on back for a hanger.

Option #3

1. Prep: Copy on 3 different colors, cut apart.
2. Students: Cut, Glue on background.
3. Tape string on back for a hanger.
