

Rock Painting

How to Paint a Rock

1. Find a rock or several rocks! (One with a smooth side for easier decorating and painting)
2. Wash the dirt from the rock with soap and water.
3. Allow rock to dry.
4. Paint your rock with Acrylic Paint. Start with one side, let dry, flip over, and paint the other side. Once you are done painting, let everything dry.
5. Do another coat of paint for longer lasting designs.
6. Embellish your rock(s) with kind messages for others, words to remember the bible passage (John 8:7) - such as FORGIVENESS, CHRIST, TEMPLE, JESUS, SIN, designs and encouraging images.
7. Place your rock around your neighbourhood for someone else to find!



Materials Needed:

- Rock or Several Rocks found outdoors around your home or from a craft store. (With a flat surface preferred)
- Acrylic Paint
- Paint Brushes (Small ones for fine details)
- Markers (oil based or permanent for writing messages)
- For longer lasting designs try coating rocks with Elmer's white glue (from local dollar store or craft store) or Mod Podge Outdoor sealer (local craft store)
